- Letter of support from your National Olympic Committee (NOC)
- Letter of support from the relevant government authority local or national such as Ministry of Sport, Education, Youth
- Completed application form

These should be signed, scanned and sent with any other supporting documents to Lúcás Ó'Ceallacháin, Development Director at <u>lucas@unitedworldwrestling.org</u> before the 12th of December 2014.

Each application will be assessed on its merits and successful applicants will be informed by the 20th of December 2014.

United World Wrestling will provide successful applicants with

- 1 wrestling mat
- Cover the cost for your lead coach to attend a training program on BTS
- Some funding to cover local costs and additional equipment requirements
