Beat the Streets is a community based movement which provides access for youth to wrestling in order to develop the full human potential of participants.

United World Wrestling is the international federation for the sport of wrestling including Olympic and non-Olympic styles.

- Letter of support from your National Olympic Committee (NOC)
- Letter of support from the relevant government authority - local or national - such as Ministry of Sport, Education, Youth
- Completed application form

These should be signed, scanned and sent with any other supporting documents to Lúcas Ó'Ceallacháin, Development Director at lucas@unitedworldwrestling.org before the 12th of December 2014.

Each application will be assessed on its merits and successful applicants will be informed by the 20th of December 2014.

- 1 wrestling mat
- Cover the cost for your lead coach to attend a training program on BTS
- Some funding to cover local costs and additional equipment requirements
