

COMPOSITION TABLE FOR TEAMS HAVING THE RIGHT TO BENEFIT FROM THE CONTRACTUAL PARTICIPATION FEE

The officials accompanying a national delegation shall be appointed on the basis of the number of wrestlers participating in the competitions, according to the following table. This composition is valid for each style and can be cumulated:

Wrestlers	1 - 3	4 - 5	6 - 10
Leaders	1	1	1
Coaches	1	2	3
Referees	-*	1*	1*
Doctors	1	1	1
Masseurs	-	-	1
TOTAL	3	5	7

* minimum number to avoid being penalized, to be selected in the list of referees authorized to officiate

Any additional member of a national delegation shall remain under the full responsibility of his/her Federation, either subject to a special accommodation fee established by the organiser, or under other conditions chosen by the Federation.

If a country participates in a competition with less than 4 wrestlers, it does not have to bring a referee with its team. Any National Federation that does not conform to the above table regarding the number of referees is liable to pay the fine laid down in the Financial Regulations, provided that it has referees in the category concerned.

Only category-I referees who were qualified on the occasion of Continental Championships (for all age groups) are authorized to work at junior and senior World Championships.

The participating Federations can present one category-I referee per mat for the World Championships and three referees of the authorized category per mat for Continental Championships. All the referees who are authorized to work will be accredited and considered under the same conditions as the participants. The organizer will obligatorily require payment of the accommodation fee from each delegation for a minimum stay of 4 days per person.
